II. Levels of Friendship

Committed Friends (Intimate Friendship) – friends who love you enough to confront you when you are wrong and to stand by you through thick and thin – for better or worse – committed to the development of each others' character, to each others' highest good, regardless of personal cost – take mutual responsibility to keep the relationship on track and growing – takes time and effort to know each other – trust them with our secrets, our weaknesses and failures, our hopes and dreams.
